YOU MUST PACK BOXES AND BAGS PROPERLY

What you put in a box or bag is dependent on an items size, weight, density and fragility.



Book Box

Glassware

Books / Magazines

Fragile / Dense Items

Wine / Alcohol



Tea Chest

Large Cookware

Clothes / Towels / Linen

Toys

Lamp Shades



Bags

Light items

Unbreakables

DO NOT PACK BOXES EXCESSIVELY HEAVY (IF YOU CANNOT LIFT THEM, WE WILL NOT)

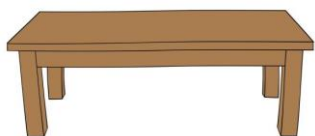
MAKE SURE THE TOP OF BOX IS FLAT SO THEY CAN BE STACKED

MARK BOXES ACCORDING TO WHERE THEY ARE GOING / MARK FRAGILE WHERE NEEDED

DO NOT USE THIN, WEAK BOXES. BOXES SHOULD BE UNIFORM

DISASSEMBLE FURNITURE WHERE NECESSARY

Disassemble your beds, dining tables and IKEA furniture where possible.



DISASSEMBLE YOUR BEDS, LONG OR HEAVY TABLES AND OVERSIZED IKEA FURNITURE BUILT INSIDE YOUR HOUSE TO SAVE SIGNIFICANT TIME

CONSIDER ITEMS THAT WERE BUILT IN YOUR HOUSE AND WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GET OUT DUE TO SIZE, TIGHT TURNS, NARROW PASSAGEWAYS – DISASSEMBLE IF SO

ALL FURNITURES CONTENTS, DRAWERS, SHELVES MUST BE EMPTIED BEFORE MOVE

move BOXES TO eASIEST ACCESS POINT IN HOME

Move all boxes, bags and other small items to the closest and easiest access point in house



Easiest and closest access points may be:

Room near Front Door

Garage

Storeroom

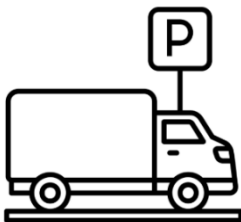
Downstairs / Elevator

DO NOT BLOCK DOORS OR ENTRY POINTS WITH BOXES

EMPTY BOXES AND ITEMS FROM BEDROOMS, ATTICS, BATHROOMS AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE

ORGANISE YOUR SPACE FOR REMOVALISTS

Plan for parking, pathways of access, permissions from neighbours or STRATA



Use cones, cars, bins or barriers to hold spots for trucks



Let your STRATA or street know you are moving to allow full unburdened access for movers



Use signage to communicate your upcoming move with community

IT IS IMPERATIVE A PARKING SPOT IS HELD FOR TRUCKS ON MOVING DAY

ARRANGE AND PLAN FOR SETTLEMENTS ON THE DAY

ENSURE ACCESS FROM STAIRS AND LIFTS ARE AVAILABLE AND CLEAR
